With October 31st falling on a home-game Saturday this season, the AUMB haunted halftime in Jordan Hare with its third show, which is simply titled "Halloween." Much of the music from the Fall 2009 halftime shows is included on this disc, along with many of the popular selections used to cheer on the tigers each Saturday in Jordan Hare.
