

The Auburn University Band Department is proud to offer the 2007-08 Marching Band CD. This year's band is part of a long and proud tradition that has, for 110 years, represented Auburn University and the state of Alabama with pride, precision, discipline, and energy. The marching band is comprised of students from across the United States and it's members represent virtually every discipline on campus.

The 2007-08 season of the AUMB was exciting and eventful and represented a milestone in the history of the program. The marching band was not only under new leadership this year, but, with the purchase of 450 new uniforms, it also had a new look. For the first time in the history of the program, the band took the field wearing an orange coat. This year also included perhaps the most active travel schedule in the history of the program. The full marching band traveled to football games against Florida, LSU, and Georgia, and a contingency of the band traveled to Fayetteville for the big game against Arkansas. The band concluded the season with a very successful trip to the Chick-fil-a Bowl in Atlanta, Georgia, where they cheered the team to an overtime victory against Clemson. In March of 2008, the AUMB took its first trip overseas when it performed at St. Patrick's Day parades in Dublin and Limerick, Ireland.

During the 07-08 season, the band performed four major halftime shows in addition to the traditional pregame show and our honor band and alumni band shows. The band opened the season with a salute to the box office, including popular themes from favorite adventure movies. For its second show, the band was proud to join forces with one of Auburn's favorite sons, American Idol winner Taylor Hicks. Our third show featured music from the alternative rock genre, and we concluded the season with a salute to the "king of rock and roll," Elvis Presley. Much of the music from the Fall 2007 halftime shows is included on this disc, along with many of the popular selections used to cheer on the tigers each Saturday in Jordan Hare. 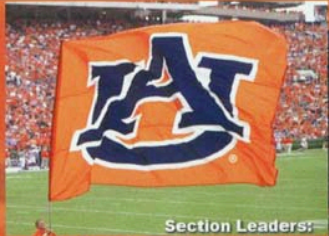
