


# GUEST SOLO ST

Jeremy Samolesky, a native of Manitoba, Canada, has been Assistant Professor of Piano at Auburn University's Music Department since 2007, where he teaches piano performance majors and serves as Piano Area Coordinator. Known for his passion for both solo and collaborative piano performances, Samolesky has appeared in concert as a soloist and chamber pianist throughout Canada, U.S.A, Italy, Austria, Hong Kong, China, Malaysia and

Singapore, including a full recital at the Kennedy Center in Washington D.C., which was broadcast nationally on National Public Radio's "Performance Today." Dr. Samolesky was also featured in a documentary on the piano music of Sergei Prokofiev, produced by the Manitoba Television Network and directed by Bill Plenty.

Samolesky achieved the rare distinction of graduating with two doctoral degrees from the Eastman School of Music: Piano Performance and Literature under the direction of Barry Snyder, and Accompanying and Chamber Music with Jean Barr. Eastman has permitted this double-doctorate just once before in the school's history. He also holds the Master of Music degree in Piano Performance from the University of Washington where he worked with Robin McCabe and the Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Manitoba where he studied with Delores Keahey.
