Vinson has announced that he plans to retire from Auburn University at the end of the 2006-2007 academic year, after thirty-six years of service to Auburn University. Since 1969 there has been one constant force associated with the Auburn University Band program; his name is Dr. Johnnie Vinson.

A member of the Auburn faculty since 1969, he previously served as Assistant Director, then as Associate Director and Director of the Marching Band before becoming Director of Bands in 1991. Dr. Vinson will be missed, but his influence on the music, experience and culture of Auburn University will be felt for years to come. His work in music education includes many years of dedicated service that has touched countless lives, making Auburn University a better place. He is a great musician, a great director, a great friend, and a great Auburn man.

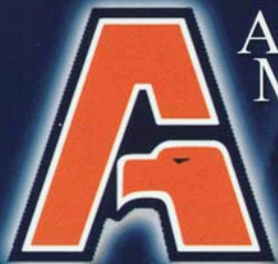
