The Arizona State University Sun Devil Marching Band is recognized as being one of the finest marching bands in the nation. The 370 member ensemble has appeared in both the Rose Bowl Half-time show as well as the 1987 and 1997 Rose Bowl Parade and was the 1991 recipient of the John Philip Sousa Foundation Sudler Trophy, which is the highest award given at the collegiate level. Performing in the 74,000 seat Sun Devil Stadium, the band features new musical arrangements as well as a mixture of precision drills and pageantry at all home games. Hard work, high standards and a family atmosphere bring a very special Sun Devil Pride that only those who have been a part of the marching band understand and share.

CONCERT BANDS

The concert bands are divided into three groups. The Symphonic Band is under the direction of Dr. Richard E. Strange and the Wind Ensemble and Concert Band are conducted by Dr. Fleming. Our bands have toured in the past, with the Wind Ensemble and Concert Band visiting high schools in the state, and the Symphonic Band giving concerts for the American Bandmasters Association (four national convention concerts), the College

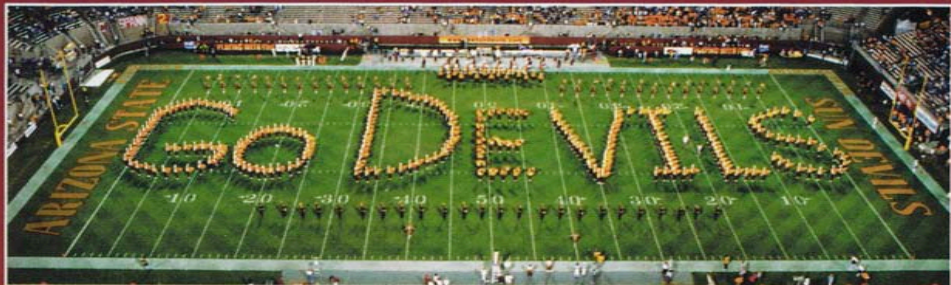
Band Directors National Association, the Music Teachers National Association and the American Society of University Composers. All three bands have a full instrumentation and play the finest in symphonic literature. Each group features soloists from within the band and from the ranks of professionals. They use distinguished guest conductors at frequent intervals and perform regularly in the world famous Grady Gammage Memorial Auditorium on the Arizona State University campus.

The incoming student is given an opportunity to take part immediately in an activity that stands at the center of campus life. Membership into any of the ASU bands is open to all university and community college students. The only prerequisite is that students have some prior instrumental music experience.
