About Mississippi State University™and the Famous Maroon Band

Mississippi State University™ is located in Starkville and is the only institution in Mississippi designated as a Doctoral I university by the Southern Regional Education Board. As a Land-Grant institution, Mississippi State® is dedicated to three broad purposes: learning, research, and service. From its beginnings, it has always been known as *The People's University*, and through many statewide efforts, MSU™ works hard to keep that character.

The band program at Mississippi State® was initiated in 1902 by an act of the Board of Trustees. Today, over 100 years later, nearly 400 students participate in the band's nine major ensembles. The 300+ member Famous Maroon Band performs at all Bulldog™ football games as well as other university functions as needed. Four concert bands comprise the concert component of the band program with the MSU™ Wind Ensemble serving as the premiere concert band. Students may also participate in two jazz bands and two basketball pep bands in addition to marching and concert bands. Band members represent almost every major at MSU™ and are among the top academic students on campus. Service awards and tuition waivers are available to both music majors and non-music majors.

The Maroon Band is part of Mississippi State's® Department of Music, whose primary mission is to develop quality music educators for the state of Mississippi and Southeast region. The department is an accredited member of the National Association of Schools of Music and currently offers the Bachelor of Music Education degree with majors in instrumental music, vocal music, piano or guitar, as well as the Bachelor of Arts degree in music.
