# COASTAL COMMUNITIES CONCERT BAND



The Coastal Communities Concert Band was organized in 1983 to provide a place for adults to share the joy, beauty, and excitement of playing an instrument with others. Beginning with 14 members, the band has grown to over 70 members, who reside throughout San Diego County. Today, it is a complete symphonic band made up of experienced musicians, attorneys, doctors, engineers, school teachers, professional musicians, and others dedicated to very high standards established by the band. The Coastal Communities Concert Band is a self-supporting, non-profit organization under the auspices of the San Dieguito Adult School. The band is well known for its "pops" style concerts at Moonlight Amphitheatre, La Jolla Cove, Rancho Santa Fe, Coronado, Del Mar, Leisure Village, Oceanside, Leisure World in Orange County, and Sun City in Las Vegas. It also enjoys performing before large audiences at its Anniversary Concerts in Carlsbad, the Holiday Concert at the California Performing Arts Center in Escondido, the OASIS Concert at the Poway Center for the Performing Arts, and the Spring Concert at Point Loma Nazarene College. In 1991, the band was invited to perform in Luzern, Switzerland for its 700th anniversary. In 1994 the band performed for the American Bandmasters' 60th annual convention in Honolulu, Hawaii, and has been invited to perform at the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (WASBE) convention in Schladming, Austria, in 1997.

The band is under the direction of Donald Caneva, a 3rd generation band director. Don is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, serves as chairman of its International Relations committee and is on its task force for strategic planning for community bands. He has been a guest conductor for many of the armed service bands as well as leading university bands around the country. Don has brought a great deal of experience, knowledge, and enthusiasm to the Coastal Communities Concert Band.
