Ingrid gives masterclasses, sits on international juries and performs across the globe: Spain, Peru, Albania, Thailand, Malaysia, Italy, New-Zealand, Hong Kong, Canada, Morocco, Australia, Switzerland, Monaco, Mauritius Island, Rodriguez, China and France.

Ingrid Riollot taught for 18 years in French Music Conservatories before moving to Australia:

Albertville, Nancy, L'Hay-Les-Roses and Montbeliard where she was the Head of guitar studies.

Since 2018, Ingrid & Damon Smallman give lectures/demonstrations about history, construction and design of Smallman Guitars

Since 2019, she is dedicating her time performing, giving masterclasses and being part of international competition juries.

She started learning music at 6 and classical guitar at 8 years old. She graduated from the National Conservatory of Music in Lyon, France where she studied with Jesus Castro-Balbi and Marc Franceries. She earned all the distinctions with the highest

rewards: First Prize Classical Guitar, Chamber Music, Analysis, Harmony and received a "Special Prize Young Talent" from the Philharmonic

She continued her post-graduated guitar studies in Barcelona, Spain with Ricardo Gallen.
She received masterclasses with: Joaquin Clerch, Marco Tamayo, Costas Cotsiolis, Gerard Abiton, Eric Franceries, Alberto Ponce.
